

Power Outage Checklist

- Water** – 1 Gallon per person per day for up to 7 days, water bottle with filter or purification tablets, flavor packets
- Food** – Non-perishable, easy to prepare items such as canned food and juice--3 day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home; paper plates, cups, and plastic silverware
- Cooler with ice**
- Flashlight and Batteries**
- Battery-powered or Crank Radio** (NOAA Weather Radio)
- First Aid Kit:**
 - 25 band aids
 - 1 roll of cloth tape
 - 5 antibiotic ointment packs, 5 alcohol wipes
 - 2 packets of aspirin
 - 1 instant cold compress
 - 2 pairs of gloves
 - Anti-itch ointment
 - 1 roller bandage
 - 2 sterile gauze pads
 - Oral Thermometer
 - Scissors
- Cooking Fuel**—with fondue pot
- Duct Tape**
- Medications** – 7-day supply
- Multi-Purpose Tool**
- Sanitation and Personal Hygiene Items:**
 - Hand Sanitizer & Baby Wipes
 - Tissues & Toilet Paper
 - Travel Shampoo & Soap
 - Toothbrush & Toothpaste
 - Towel & Washcloth
- Cell Phones** – fully charged, extra battery
- Cash & Credit Cards**
- Important Documents** – Save to a flash drive if possible:
 - Insurance Cards & Medical Records
 - Bank Account Numbers/Documents
 - Social Security Card & ID Card
 - Birth Certificates
- Full Change of Clothes, Raingear, Boots**
- Blankets, Pillows, Sleeping Bags**
- Family & Emergency Contact Information**
- Pet Food, Water, Bowls, & Vet Records**
